## Brief History of the Department

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The Department of B.Ed. of Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya is situated in the historical place *Tamralipta*, The Head Quarter of Purba Medinipur District on the bank of River Rupnarayana. It is 3 kms away from Tamruk Railway Station and 5 Kms from Nimtouri Bus stoppage, NH-41.

The B.Ed. Department was introduced in Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya in the session 1965-66 with the affiliation of Calcutta University in-terms of Memo No-C/35/122 (affl). dt. 07.07.1965. From the session 1985-86 the department came under the affiliation of Vidyasagar University as per the Govt. order, in-terms Memo No. 983-Edu (u), dt. 23.05.1985.

The department has been duly recognized by NCTE (ERC) Bhubaneswar, Vide memo no. ERC/7-78(1).9/2007/69199, dated- Aug 06, 2007. Further the department has been recognized by new NCTE regulations, 2014, revised order no. F.ERC/NCTE/(APE00715)/B.Ed.(revised Order)/2015/32358, dated -29.05.2015.

It has been fulfilling the burning need of training of the Secondary and higher secondary pre and in-service teachers with a galaxy of scholarly teacher Educators. Now it has become the oldest and glorious Teachers Training Centre in the Purba Medinipur district.

The department started with an intake capacity of 125 seats of which 63 seats were for Deputed teachers and 62 seats for fresher candidates. Initially the method subjects which were taught Bengali, English, History, Mathematics and elective subjects like Mental Hygiene and Mental and Educational Measurement. Subsequently two other method subjects Geography and physical science was introduced in 2003 for need of B.Ed. students. The above mentioned method subjects and elective subjects were taught up to academic year 2014-15. As per N.C.T.E. rules and regulations, 2014, the pedagogy of Language Teaching, Social Science Teaching, Science Teaching, Mathematics Teaching and optional paper like Environmental and population

education, Work and Vocational Education and Guidance and counselling were introduced from the Academic session 2015-2016.

From the very beginning 05 Faculty posts were sanctioned and in 2006 two more posts had been sanctioned in the Department by higher Education Dept. W.B. The dept was enriched by a number of renowned teachers- Prof. Santosh Kumar Ghosh, Prof. Gourdas Halder, Prof. Asoke gupta, Prof. Upendranath Manna, Prof. Nirmal Chandra Das. The department had been enriched by their endless service regarding teaching and learning and other activities.

The department provides advanced facilities in teaching learning process through the use of ICT that is Internet, Power point presentation(PPT), Audio-Video, You Tube, Smart Board and Over head Projector. Our department also facilitates teaching learning process by use of improvised low cost / no cost teaching Aids, Model, Chart, Maps etc. Our department is also well equipped with Laboratories i.e. physical science lab, Geography Lab, psychology Lab, Computer Lab and educational Technology lab . Subsequently a enriched library exist in our department.

The Department monitors the performance of the students through regular class tests, Micro- Teaching, Internship in different schools, remedial measures like personal counselling, tutorial, remedial coaching, group discussion, seminar assignment, survey work, field trips and awareness programme etc. Also students are accomplished with school based activities and community based activities during internship period. The students are being developed their skill in teaching- learning during internship period in different schools. Further students are being upgraded their skill by doing practicum work i.e. Field Trips, Field survey, Awareness program of population and pollution etc.

The Department provides different co-curricular activities i.e. games and sports, literary and magazine, social and cultural and educational excursion.

Apart from their duties in Teaching- Learning , the faculty members are always trying for upgrading themselves by participating in workshops and seminars, Faculty Development Programme(FDP), delivering lecture in different workshops and seminars and publishing articles in journals and books. They also act as evaluator / examiner, paper setter, moderator and member of different administrative and professional bodies.

The Department follows the curriculum designed and approved by vidyasagr University up to academic year 2014-15. From academic year 2015-16 the department has come under uniform curriculum structure for two year Teacher Education

Programmes following NCTE regulations,2014, prepared by the curriculum committee constituted by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal.

Students of the department appeared in UGC-NET, CSIR-NET / GATE/SET/TIFR/BARC/GRE/TOFEL etc. exam while pursuing the course or after passing the course. It is seen that almost 30-40% students per year passed the said exam. Most of the students appeared in TET and CTET for being a teacher. Above 50% students passed the TET or CTET exam. Besides some students appeared in state level and central level competitive service exam while pursuing B.Ed. course/ after passing B.Ed. course. Every year students are doing Ph.D. work in different Universities and IIT's after passing B.Ed. course. Some students but not least appeared in C.S.C. those who are passed NET of SET pursuing the B.Ed. course or after passing the B.Ed. course some students.
